- Spend some quality time with an elderly person in the family.

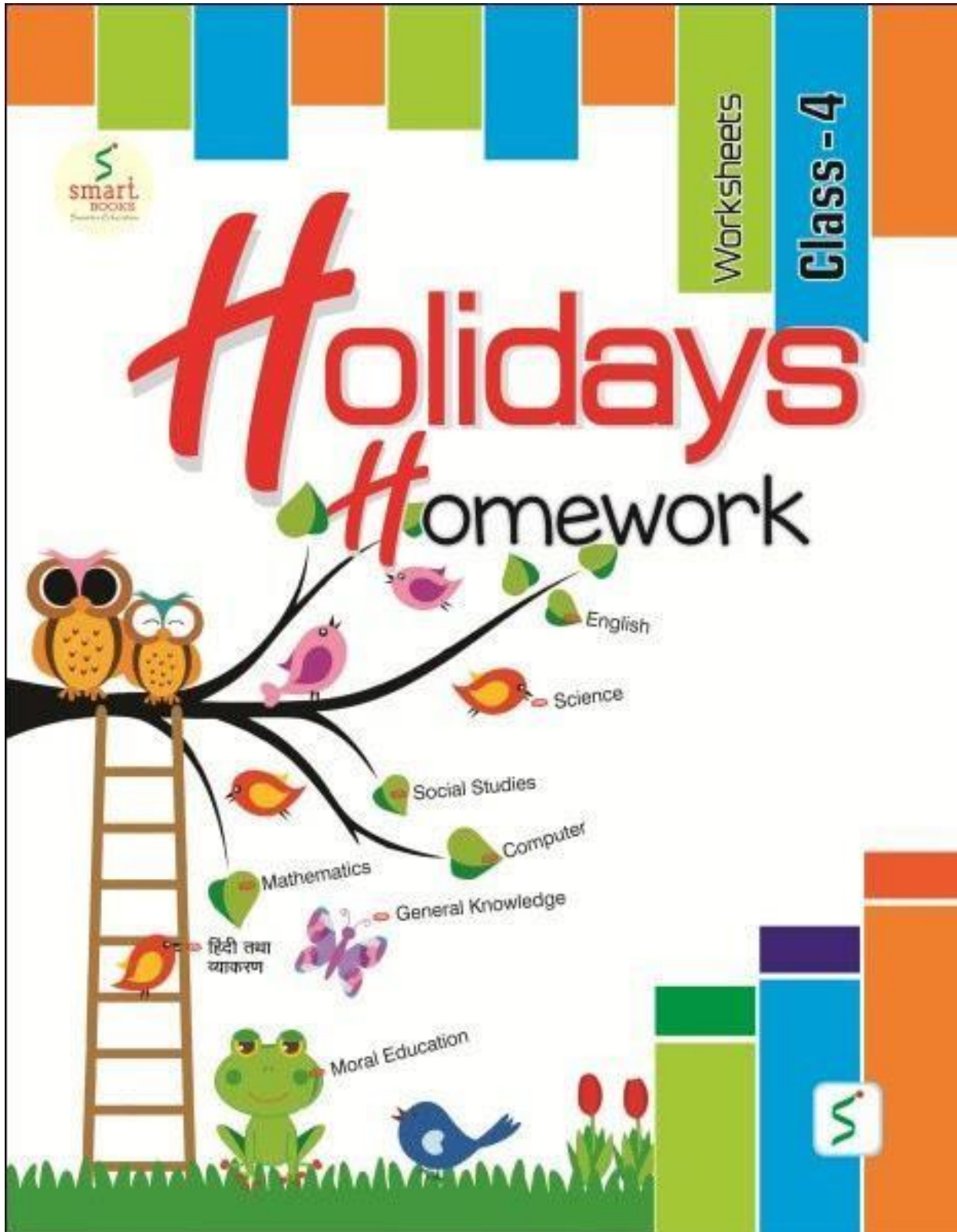
Instructions for Kids:

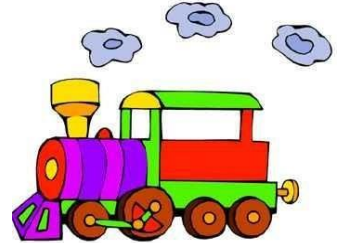

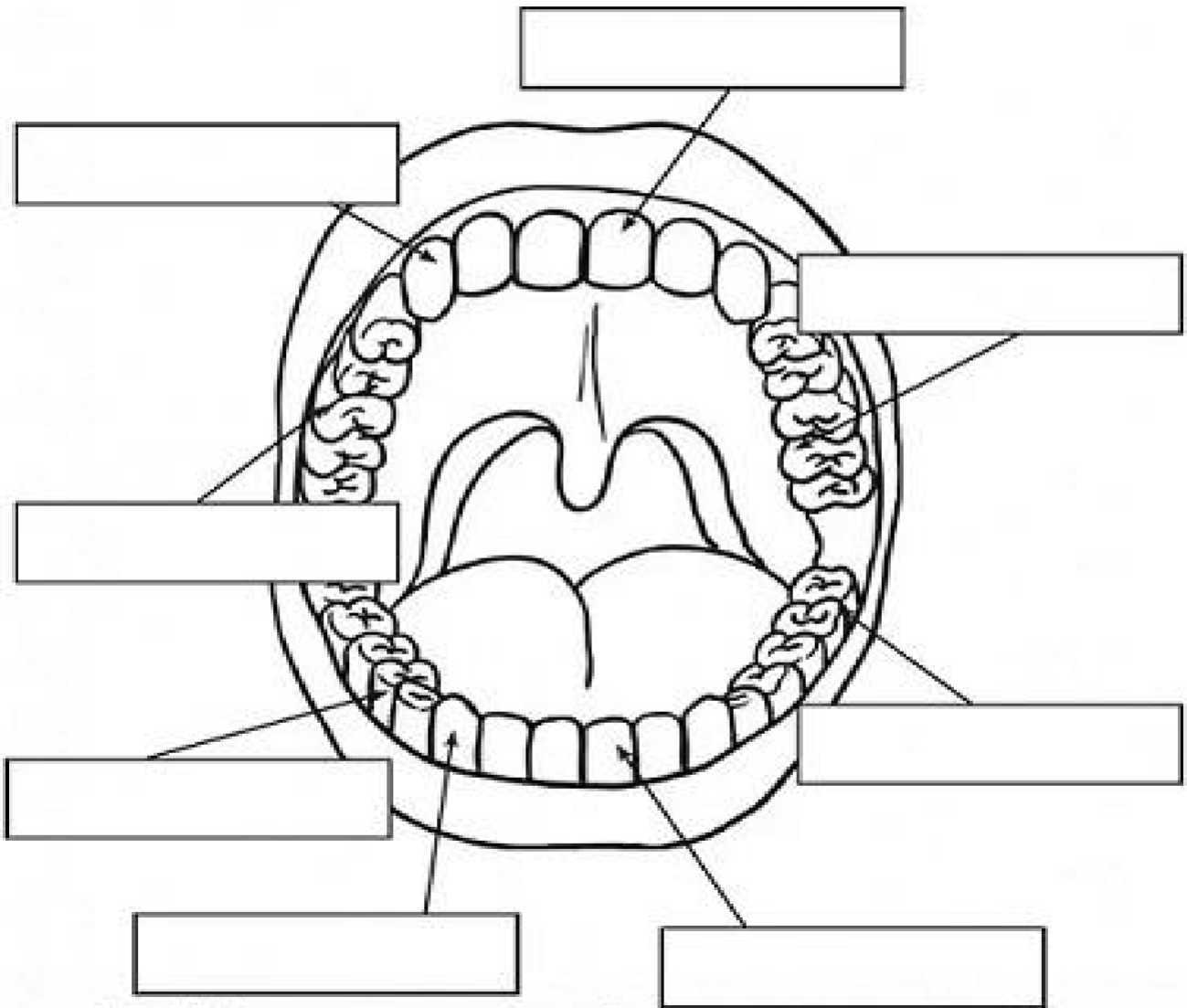

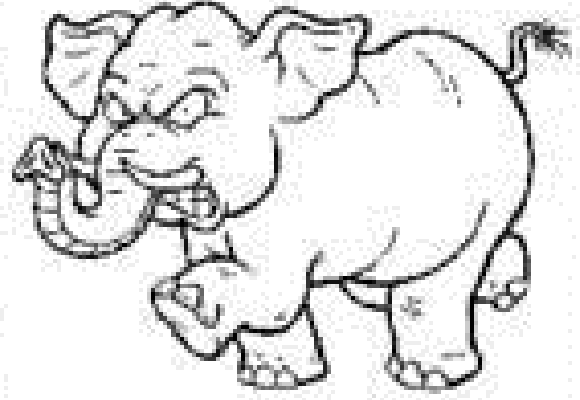
